Department Overview:

Middleton Fire District (population 12,500) is in the City of Middleton and portions of Canyon and Gem Counties. Located just 25-miles West of Boise, Middleton is a farming community and is very close to major towns of Nampa, Caldwell, Boise, and Meridian.

Middleton Fire District has been serving our community since being organized in 1958 and is a full-service Fire and EMS. Our Service Area is approximately 110 square miles in the City of Middleton, Canyon and Gem Counties responding to 1638 incidents in 2016 from one station. Our staff currently operates on a 48/96 A-B-C schedule.

Job Requirements

US Citizen: Yes, and Can lawfully work in the U.S.

High School Grad/GED: Yes

Valid Idaho State Driver's License: Yes, **must pass driving records check** and, if hired, maintain a driving record that meets the Districts standard.

Ability to Read/Speak English: Yes

Medical/ Vision: candidate will need to successfully complete and pass the fire districts NFPA 1582 medical/ vision exam performed by the designated department physician.

Prior Experience Required: Candidate **MUST** submit in writing detailed previous structural and wildland experience as it relates to being an officer, over the last 24 months. **BE SPECIFIC**

Necessary Certifications:

The following certifications need to be hand delivered or emailed to vislas@middletonfire.org

- Idaho EMT Idaho certification by start date. National Registry or other state certified EMT must meet the State of Idaho EMT certification requirements and are responsible for applying for reciprocity to ensure they have Idaho EMT certification by start date. - CPR- candidates must possess American Heart Association certifications before start date.
- IFSAC FF-1, FF-2, / TVODP, or an equivalent certification. If the candidate holds an equivalent certification, it will be their responsibility to provide substantiating documentation for consideration by the Middleton Fire District. The decision on whether to accept the certification will be at the discretion of the Middleton Fire District. “The Deputy Chief’s determination shall be final.”
- Wildland FF Type 2, If the candidate holds an equivalent certification, S-130, S-190 it will be their responsibility to provide substantiating documentation for consideration by the Middleton Fire District. The decision on whether to accept the certification will be at the discretion of the Middleton Fire District. “The Deputy Chief’s determination shall be final.”

Specific Disqualifiers/Behaviors:

A background investigation is completed for this position, which is more than a simple records check. While conviction and driving history is considered once a candidate reaches the background investigation stage of the process, there are other factors considered.

Conviction history will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Typically, the nature of the crime, time elapsed since the crime, and the nature of the position are factors that may be considered
